Education support, food distribution, medical support, emergency relief, shelter, welfare to the poor, supporting orphans and widows, empowering the women and creating self-employment opportunities are some of the primary programs supported by your donations to IREC.

A dedicated team of highly experienced leaders and volunteers work directly with the beneficiaries. They work diligently to identify the needs and make the best use of available resources resulting in getting the best output and maximizing the benefits of your generous donations.

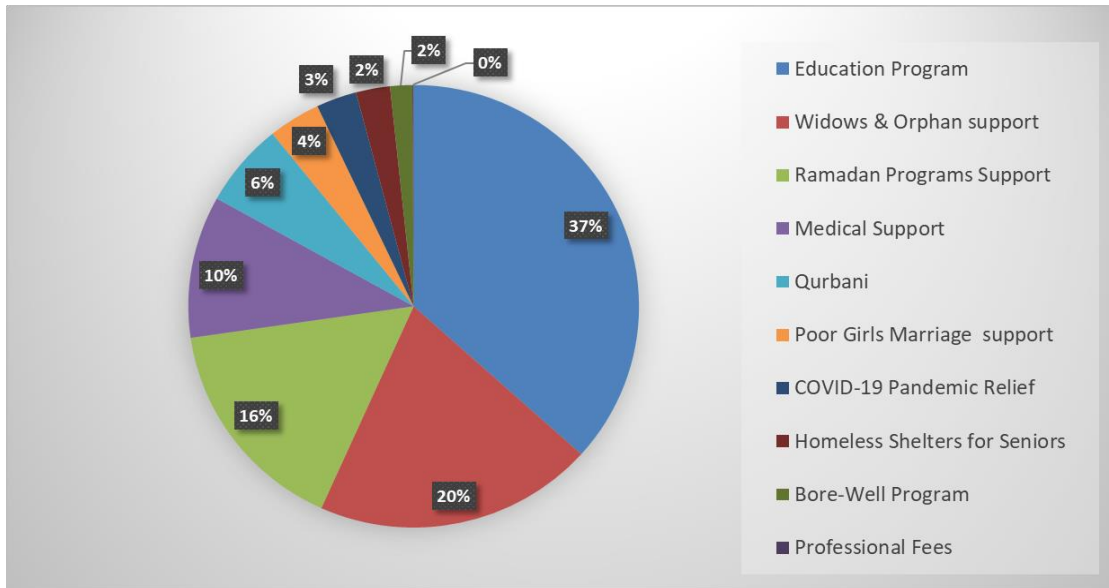
