#### **Orphan and Poor Girls Marriage Support**

One of the major areas your donations are used is to provide financial support for marriages of orphan girls and girls belonging to poor families. IREC and its volunteers make a thorough effort to verify the financial status of the girls we support for marriage, making sure that the money is given to deserving girls and also that the money is spent only on absolute necessities of the marriage.

During this financial year IREC was able to identify and support 6 marriages, 4 orphan girls and 2 girls belonging to poor families. This support, provided in the form of financial aid, was 30,000 Rupees per marriage. A total of Rs. 180,000 was utilized to support this noble cause.

#### Widow and Destitute Families Support

Monetary support to the widows, orphans and destitute families is another way IREC utilizes your donations. The beneficiaries are identified by going through a verification and screening process that includes visiting the houses and verifying their living conditions and socio economic status. Once a family is identified as a deserving recipient of your monthly donations, IREC will provide a monthly support to meet the basic household expenses. The amount is based on the family size and their needs.

During 2015, 11 families were provided support each month with the average aid being Rs 2,500 per family.

#### Ramadan Food Drive Program

Every year during Ramadan, IREC delivers food packets to the needy families of the rural areas. During this year, Alhamdulillah we were able to distribute food supplies to more than 100 families in rural areas where they struggle immensely to feed themselves and their families.


#### **Water Wells Program**

Water is the basic necessity of life. There are many rural areas that struggle for drinking water. Families have to travel long distances to get a pot of water. Each bore well costs Rs 65,000 (\$1000) to install.. IREC was able to complete two bore wells in 2015 for a total cost of Rs 130,000 (\$2000).

We plan to continue this project in the future with generous contribution from donors like you and our goal is to reach more rural areas that are desperate without water In Shaa Allah.
