IREC 2018 Summary of Activities and Programs

Education Support

Scholarship program designed to uplift the deserving members of our community. A total of 394 students were supported, including students of professional degree courses like Medicine, Engineering, and Pharmacy. In addition to this some students received job related vocational training helping them launch into job market.

We also support the students with school supplies and uniforms.

To maintain the integrity of this program, IREC continuously monitors the grades and progress of all the students benefiting from these programs.

Medical Support

A hallmark program aimed to support the most critical situations of the community. IREC takes pride in using your donations to provide lifesaving treatments for conditions like Cancer, Kidney transplant, Open heart surgery and more. Home healthcare and medications delivery is provided for elderly patients.

Funds are paid directly to the hospitals and pharmacies towards their bills and cost of medications.

Orphan & Poor Girls Marriages

Facilitating marriages of poor and orphan girls is a very noble cause and an absolute need of the current society. We receive numerous requests for this purpose.

IREC and its dedicated volunteers thoroughly verify the financial status of the girls we support for marriage and disburse the needed funds to highly deserving girls. Money is spent only on absolute necessities of the marriage.

Widow and Destitute Support

Widows are provided a monthly pension to take care of their vital needs including food, housing and medical expenses.

Destitute families are helped with their immediate needs in times of hardship.

<u>Orphan Support</u>

Orphan children are fully supported with all their needs of food, clothing, shelter and educational expenses. Support is also given for any emergency need that arises from time to time. All the living costs for these orphan children are sponsored by IREC while they reside with their guardians. Efforts are put to make these children selfsufficient and look forward to a brighter future.

Self-Employment Support

Training is imparted to people of all genders and ages with focus on improving their job skills. Computer classes, tailoring and auto mechanic are some examples of skilled training that is provided by IREC. Getting people ready to enter the job market so they can have a fair chance at opportunities in the competitive work field.

<u>Ramadan Programs</u>

Our annual Ramadan program is geared to cater to the most needful areas with services like supply of food packets for the entire month, Iftaar on a daily basis in rural masajid, arrangement for taraweeh and distribution of EID clothes to orphan kids.

Water Wells & Bore-Wells

IREC Volunteers lookout for areas with water scarcity and facilitate installation of bore wells. Providing safe drinking water to the people of remote area communities and schools is the ultimate goal of this program.

Emergency Relief


