Education Support

Scholarship program designed to uplift the deserving members of our community.

Providing educational opportunities to the children and youth of struggling families is IREC core program that is funded by your contributions. A total of 794 students were supported in 2023, including students of professional degree courses like Medicine, Engineering, and Pharmacy.

IREC provides funding in the form of total annual fees to individuals from KG to Degree programs paid directly to the educational institution. To keep the students motivated and on track for the best utilization of your funds, grades are monitored on a regular basis. Counseling is provided to students to keep them on track to succeed.

Apart from paying tuition fees to the students we also run after school board examination coaching by setting up coaching classes with highly qualified and experienced teachers who help in improving the performance of the students to succeed in board exams.

Education is a tool that takes care of not just the needy individual but their generations.

Social Welfare Support

IREC runs a wide variety of programs that are geared towards helping the disadvantaged sections of society. By the grace of Almighty, these programs have been able to reach to a huge population. Your donations go a long way to help sustain these programs.

IREC has initiated women's empowerment program to provide self-employment training and skills to widows and destitute women at no cost. We operate training centers with full time teachers and other necessary staff. These centers are equipped with various tools like automatic sewing machines, embroidery machines and other tools needed for coaching.

Computer training classes are offered for boys and girls on basic skill development programs. Automotive mechanic is a nine-month vocational training provided by IREC where the students are provided boarding and meals along with the classes.

IREC also provides resources and opportunities to the deserving people to become independent and self-sustaining. Through Our self-employment support program, we provide funds for establishment of small businesses. Volunteers work directly with beneficiaries to set up the business.

Self-employment support creates a group that does not need to rely on other form of donations. They are not only able to take care of their own families but in some cases are able to create opportunities for other less fortunate people.

All these facilities are provided free of cost to the deserving beneficiaries.





Hospital Construction

Among a multitude of projects managed by IREC, Medical support is one of the core projects. In the past 10 years we have supported hundreds of poor families with their medical necessities.

A vast number of families go through absolute hardship trying to procure basic medical facilities including but not limited to necessary medications, lab tests, dialysis, and hospital care.

Demand for medical support in rural areas has been growing rapidly due to lack of hospitals and doctors in these areas. To fill this void, IREC has undertaken a project to build a multi-specialty charitable hospital called SAHARA MEDICAL CENTER.

Providing medical care in a community of 500,000 people with no facility within a 20-kilometer radius is the goal of this project. Most of this population is at or below poverty level.

Construction has been going on and we have successfully completed three phases of this project with two more phases left to turn this into a fully functional facility.

We need your support to help us achieve the goal of providing quality medical care to the most deserving sections of our community.





Orphans, Widows and Destitute Support

Monetary support to the widows, orphans and destitute families is another way IREC utilizes your donations. The beneficiaries are identified by going through a verification and screening process that includes visiting the houses and verifying their living conditions and socio-economic status.

Orphan children are fully supported with all their needs of food, clothing, shelter, and educational expenses. Support is also given for any emergency need that arises from time to time. All the living costs for these orphan children are sponsored by IREC while they reside with their guardians. Efforts are put to make these children self-sufficient and look forward to a brighter future.

Widows are provided a monthly pension to take care of their vital needs including food, housing, and medical expenses.

Destitute families are helped with their immediate needs in times of hardship. IREC will provide a monthly support to meet the basic household expenses. The amount is determined on the basis of family size and their needs. These payments are deposited directly to the bank accounts of the beneficiaries.

Highlights:

Alhamdulillah 100% of donations and contributions go to the actual beneficiaries through different IREC programs.

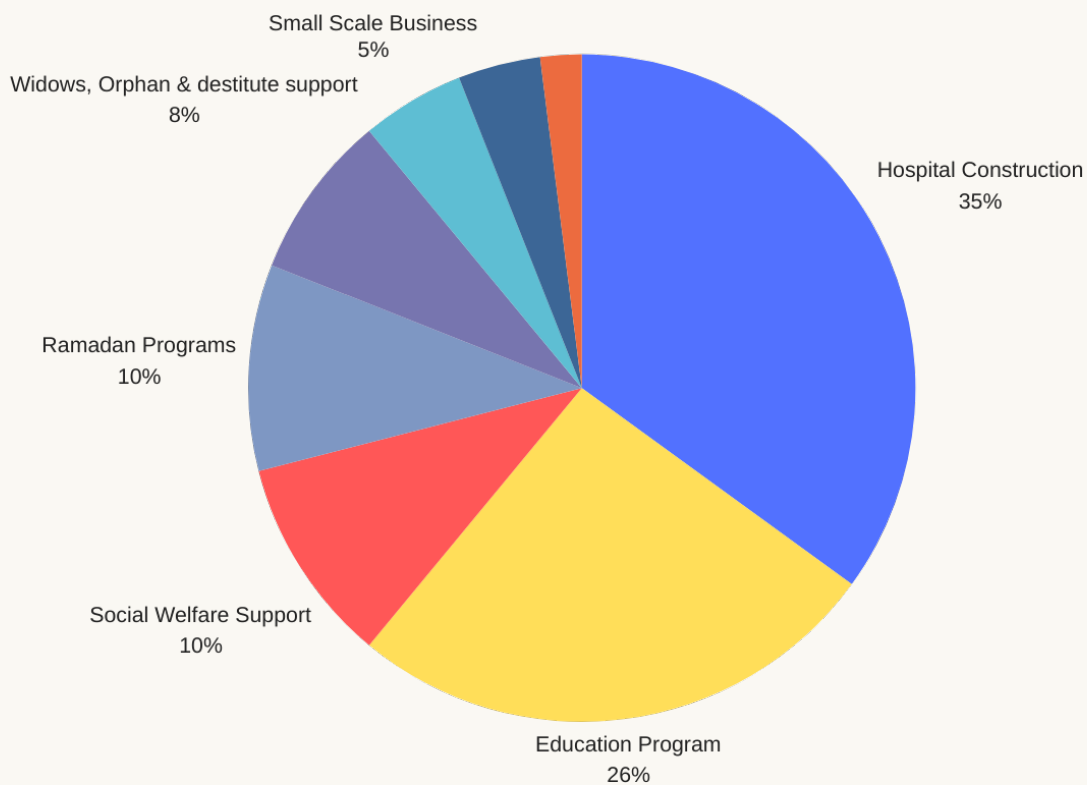
All IREC directors, support staff, and field staff are volunteers and work at no cost to IREC. There are no salaried employees. The overhead expenses to IREC are minimal to zero.
